## RULES FOR AWARDING ROLL OF HONOUR

### 1. Roll of Honour for Academics

A candidate should have secured minimum 75% in aggregate and first position in the college in the last University examinations in Honors' or Pass Course.

OR

A candidate should have secured one of the top five positions in the University examinations in Honours or pass course.

### 2. Roll of Honour for NCC

A candidate should have represented in the Republic Day Parade at New Delhi during the current session.

A candidate should have been selected and attended International Youth Exchange Programme (YEP) in another country.

A candidate should have won I<sup>st</sup>/II<sup>nd</sup>/III<sup>rd</sup> position in All India Thal/Nau/Vayu sainik Camp

### 3. Roll of Honour for NSS

A candidate should have participated in the Republic Day Parade.

OR

A candidate should have been selected and attended International Youth Exchange Programme (YEP) in another country.

OR

Recipient of Indra Gandhi Youth Award

### 4. Roll of Honour for excelling in Cultural Activities

A Candidate should have earned a position at National Level/ Inter University level.

OR

A Candidate should have participated in any item at the International Level competition.

OR

He/ She should have won five or more first positions in Inter college competitions in one event only during the year.

OR

He/ She should have won ten or more first positions in Inter College Competitions in one event only during his total stay in the college.

### 5. **Roll of Honour for Excelling in Sports**

A candidate should have earned a position at National Level/Inter University level .

OR

A candidate who is a member of a National team.

OR

A candidate who creates a new record in the Punjab University/ State / National meet.

### 6. **Roll of Honour for Blood Donation**

A candidate should have donated Blood eight times or more during his stay in the college.

## **RULES FOR AWARDING COLLEGE COLOURS**

### 1. **College Colours in Academics**

A candidate should be awarded College Colours only in final year of all the streams with consistently good record in the University and House Examination. He/ She should have secured at least 75% marks in aggregate and have secured 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> position in aggregate in college.

### 2. **College Colour for NCC**

He/ She should have been declared the Best Cadet at a Directorate Level NCC Camp

OR

He/ She should have been selected and attend Thal Sainik/ Nau Sainik/ Vayu Sainik Camp, IMA Training / Air Attachment/ Ship Attachment Camp.

### 3. **College Colour for Sports**

A candidate should have been declared the best athlete during the current year

OR

He/ She should have participated at the Inter-University / National / Inter –Zonal level

OR

A candidate should have secured 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> position at the University/ State level in the individual event

OR

A candidate who is a member of the team which has secured 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> position at the University / State level

#### **4. College Colour for Cultural Activities**

A candidate should have secured 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> position in the Inter Zonal Youth Festival during the session

OR

He / She should have participated at the National Level in the current session

OR

A candidate should be a winner or runner up in the State Youth Festival during the session

OR

A candidate should have secured 1<sup>st</sup> position in the Zonal Youth Festival during the session

#### **5. College Colour for Blood Donation**

A candidate should have donated Blood five times or more during his stay in the college

#### **6. College Colour for NSS**

A candidate should have attended three NSS camp and should have been declared an outstanding NSS volunteer in at least one camp

#### **7. College Colour for Office Bearers of Student's Council**

The College colours will be awarded to the four Office bearers of the Student Council during the current session

#### **8. College Magazine**

A student should have worked as Chief Editor of the College Magazine during the current session.

#### **9. College Library**

A student should have been recommended by the College librarian who excelled in Library activities during the preceding three years and has been awarded merit certificates during the two years.

## **RULES FOR AWARDING MERIT CERTIFICATES**

### **1. Academics**

- (a) A student should have secured 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the Mid Semester Examination in a subject with at least 60% marks.
- (b) A student should have secured 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> / 3<sup>rd</sup> position in the college in the Panjab University Annual Examination in the preceding year.

The prizes are also to be given to the position holders in the aggregate in each class

### **2. NCC: A Cadet**

- (a) Should have attended National Integration Camp

OR

- (b) Should have attended Pre Thal Sainik or Equivalent Camp

OR

- (c) Should have been adjudged the best Senior Cadet of NCC

### **3. Sports**

- (a) A student who has captained any College team.
- (b) A student should have participated at State level.
- (c) A student who has been adjudged Best player in any game or sport, who has played for the college.
- (d) A student who has been selected by the Panjab University to attend the PU Coaching Camp in any game or event.
- (e) Student who have been declared best athlete of different streams.

### **4. Blood Donation**

A student should have donated Blood three times in the Blood Donation Camp held in the College during his/her stay in the college.

### **5. Cultural Activities**

- (a) A student should have won 2<sup>nd</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> position PU Zonal Youth Festival in the current session.
- (b) He/She should have won three prizes at the Inter College competitions in the current session.

## **6. NSS**

A volunteer should have attended two 10 days NSS Camps and should have been declared the Best Volunteer for at least one time.

## **7. College Magazine**

Student editors of the College Magazine shall be awarded Merit Certificates.

## **8. Student Council**

A student elected as member of the Student Council other than the Office Bearers are to be given Merit Certificates.

The students taking their claims to any of the Honours in the Current Session must have also adhered to the following:

1. There should not be any case of indiscipline, misbehavior and breach of college/Hostel rules against the student during his stay in the college.
2. He/She should not have failed in any University Examination.
3. He/She should have attended 75% lectures in the subject he/she have opted. He/She should have cleared the academic condition House Test held in the college during the session.
4. The students should attach documentary proof(photocopies) in support of their claims.
5. All claims must reach the conveners by the last date mentioned in the notice.

**However the College Award Committee may consider any other case for Award of Honours to students involved in various other activities held in the College. Merely qualifying for the Award does not confer a right on the candidate for the Award.**
