Subject: Incentives to NCC Certificate holders in recruitment to the State Police Forces- reg.

As you may be aware that National Cadet Corps (NCC) in India was formed through the National Cadet Corps Act of 1948. National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force wings. It is engaged in grooming the youth into disciplined and patriotic citizens. NCC cadets are imparted basic military and weapon training by the Service Officers of Armed Forces.


2. The Ministry of Home Affairs has decided to grant incentives to NCC Certificate holders in direct recruitment for the post of Sub-Inspectors and Constables in Central Armed Police Forces. A copy of the press brief dated 19.03.2020 issued in this regard is enclosed.

3. The incentives to NCC Certificate holders will be granted at the following scales:-

Certificate Category	Incentive/Bonus marks
NCC 'C' Certificate	5% of the maximum marks of the examination
NCC 'B' Certificate	3% of the maximum marks of the examination
NCC 'A' Certificate	2% of the maximum marks of the examination

4. All State Governments/UT Administrations are advised to grant similar incentives to NCC Certificate holders in the direct recruitment examinations for their respective Police Forces.
