

Subject- Re-opening of Higher Education / Technical Institutions, U.T., Chandigarh.

Kindly refer to Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India order dated 27.01.2021 and UGC guidelines dated 05.11.2020 for reopening the Universities and Colleges (Post Lockdown due to COVID-19 Pandemic).

After considering the letters referred above, it has been decided to re-open Higher Educational / Technical Institutions in U.T., Chandigarh from 10.02.2021 onwards subject to the following details:-

- i) Students may be allowed to attend offline classes, however, attendance will not be mandatory.
- ii) Teaching will continue in blended mode (offline and online) in the interest of all students.
- iii) Hostels may be opened in Institutions by following the COVID-19 prevention instructions. Hostel Room may be allotted to one student (where ever possible) or according to the size of room on sharing basis for the safety/ distancing of students. Preference may be given to the final year students at the time of allotment.
- iv) In the Colleges/ Institutes the Mess/ Canteen etc. may be opened by taking care of Proper COVID Precautions.
- v) UGC guidelines dated 05.11.2020 will be adopted by the institutions as per their local needs / conditions.
- vi) Head of the Institutions will be responsible for ensuring compliance of instructions of MHA (Government of India), Ministry of Education, UGC and Chandigarh Administration issued from time to time.
- vii) Each Head of Institution will develop his/her own detailed SOP for re-opening of campuses keeping in view the safety and health of the students and staff.
