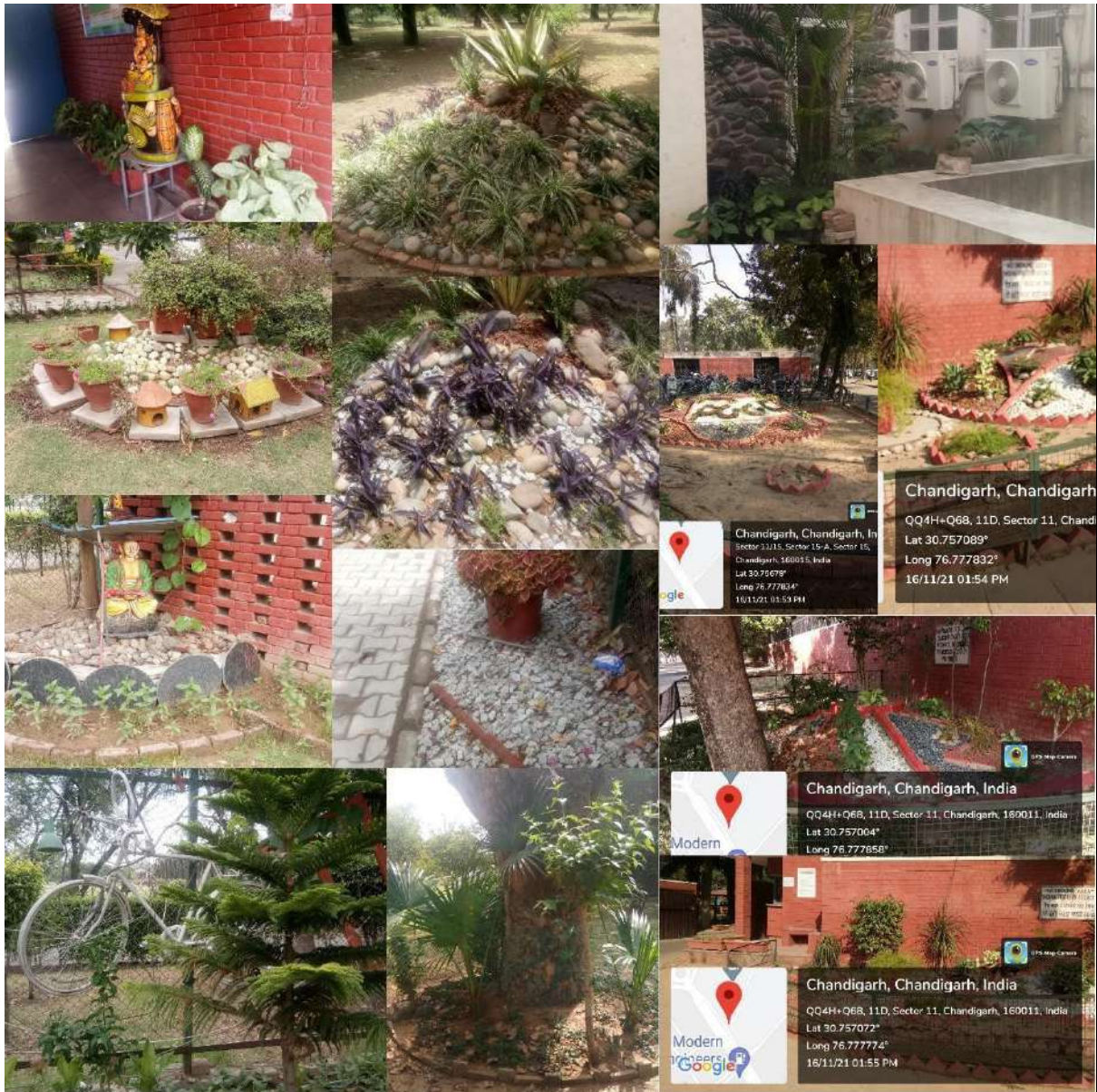

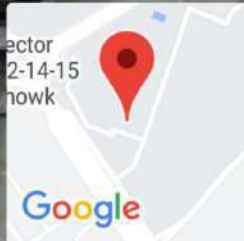
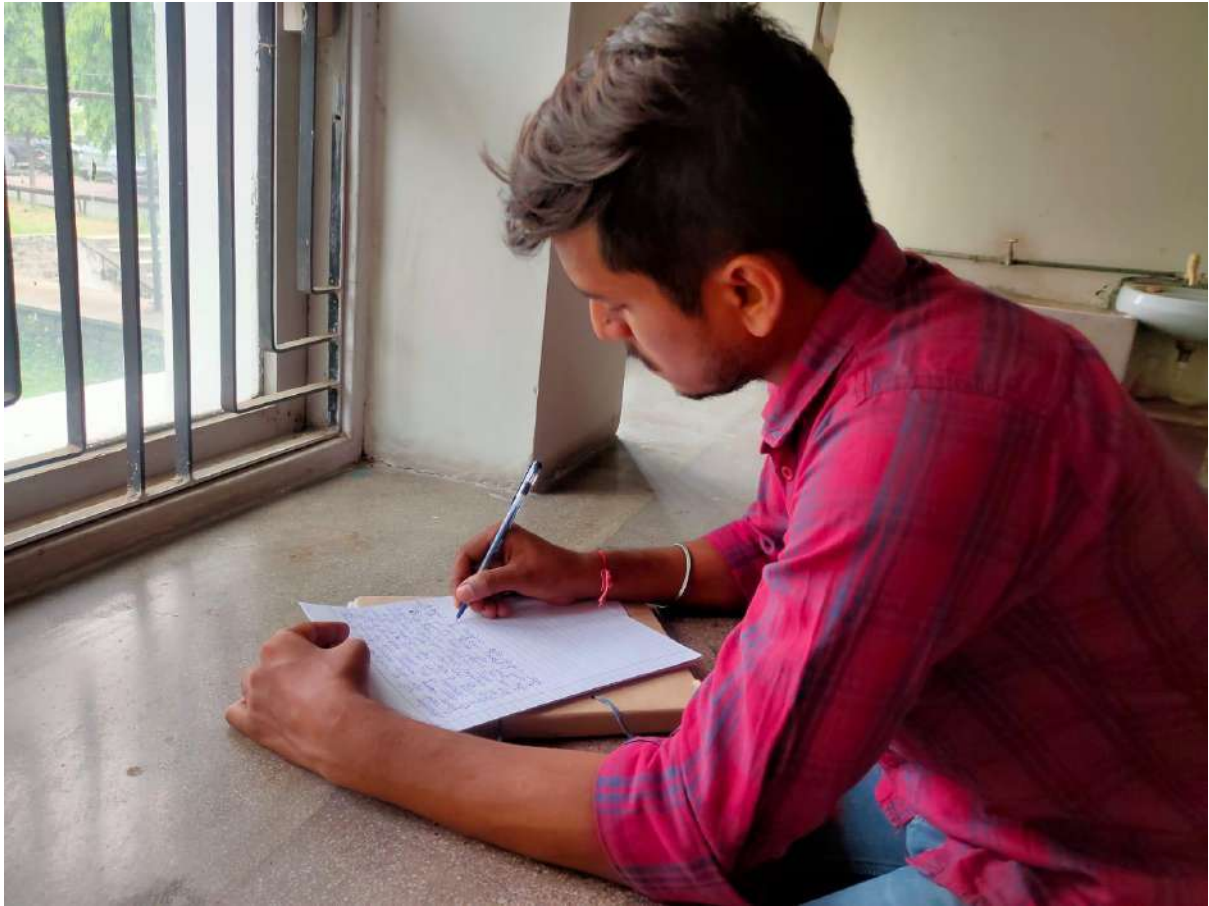

1. *Display material regarding segregation of waste*

The college also organised awareness rallies in and around the college campus and also conducted sensitization lecture on waste segregation for all the Class III and Class IV employee of the college.

4. Poster making competitions were also conducted to create awareness among the harmful effects of plastics and the importance of cleanliness.
5. Cleanliness drive was conducted by the Class IV employees of the college at all the locations.
6. Awareness campaigns were also conducted by the students at the desired locations of the college.
7. Reuse of used milk pouches were collected from the college canteen as well as mess and reuse them to plant saplings.
8. Best out of waste model making competition was organised to realize the importance of adopting 3R's.
9. Faculty as well as students were encouraged to carry their own water bottles as well as small bins in their vehicles with an aim to minimize waste generation within the campus.
