Feedback on-	Action taken
Relevance of the curriculum for better employability	Faculty members, who are the members of Board of Studies of the affiliating university, conveyed the need to upgrade the curriculum to meet the need of industry and service sector.
Availability of adequate ICT facilities for teaching and learning	Further enhancement in the ICT facilities was carried out. 1. Internet lease line upgraded to 150 mbps from 100mbps. 2. All classrooms and laboratories were Wi-Fi enabled. 3. Interactive panels were installed in 3 more classrooms. So now there are total of 27 smart classrooms in the college. 4. 56 desktops were purchased for the use of students and academic work in this session taking the total to 307 desktops and 45 laptops.
Use of innovative teaching methods	1. Syllabus related e-content in 26 subjects are made available on the college website. 2. Students are made aware of various portals that provide them free access to e-resources and courses like SWAYAM, NASSCOM, e-PATHSHALA etc. to compliment classroom teaching. 3. Quizzes, tests, power point presentations, case study methods were used along with the classroom teaching.
Curriculum facilitates holistic growth	1. Activities such as outreach activities, participation in National/International day celebrations and cultural activities were undertaken for better results and holistic development. 2. To motivate and nurture the curiosity of the students, expert lectures were organized in the faculties of Science, Commerce and Humanities. 3. Along with the classroom teaching various other co-curricular activities such as educational tours, field visit, presentations, workshops, seminars etc. were taken up. 4. Debates, declamations, case studies, internships were organized to instil the values of discipline, team spirit and self-confidence. 5. Inter and Intra College competition on various themes relating to academics and current affairs were organized.
